The results are in. A whopping 45 olive oils were entered in the Harvest Fair's annual Olive Oil Competition. Ten different varieties were represented, producers from four local regions were on display, 15 Double Gold medals and 17 Golds were bestowed upon the top winners.

A select team of judges spent a full day evaluating each entry based on sensory attributes, quality and adherence to very specific category standards. The oil that came out on top and took home the fair's highest honor with a Double Gold and Best of Show was a Picholine Blend EVOO from Sebastopol's Gold Ridge Organic Farms.

"We are blessed with one of the best growing environments for producing world class olive oils. It's gratifying that the judges appreciated the quality of our picholine extra virgin oil this year," said Brooke Hazen, Farmer/Owner of Gold Ridge Organic Farms.
